Muster Points

In the event of an emergency, please proceed to one of the designated muster points.

1. **Lions Garage (Front)**
 - Located at the front of the campground near the main entrance.
 2. **North End of Campground**
 - Located at the north fence of campground, behind the fire station.
 3. **Oilfields Regional Arena**
 - Exit the campground and turn right onto 5th St., then turn left onto 5th Ave., and finally turn right onto 3rd St.

List of Emergency Equipment

The following emergency equipment is available within the campground:

- **AED (Automated External Defibrillator)**
 - Location: Campground office
 - **First Aid Kit[s]**
 - Location: Campground office and Lions Garage
 - **Fire Extinguishers Locations**
 - Campground office
 - Campground washroom [exterior wall]
 - Inside door of Lions Garage

Emergency Procedures

Fire:

1. Alert others by shouting "Fire!"
2. Evacuate the area immediately.
3. Use a fire extinguisher
4. Proceed to the nearest muster point.
5. Call 911 and provide details of the fire location and any known hazards.

Medical Emergency:

1. Call 911 and provide detailed information about the emergency.
2. Use the AED or first aid kit if needed.
3. Stay with the injured person until emergency services arrive.
4. Direct emergency services to the location if necessary.

Severe Weather:

1. Seek shelter in a sturdy building. [washroom or Lions Garage]
2. Follow local emergency broadcast instructions.
3. Proceed to the nearest muster point once it is safe to do so.

Evacuation:

1. Remain calm and do not rush.
 2. Follow posted evacuation routes and instructions from emergency personnel.
 3. Proceed to the nearest muster point.
 4. Do not re-enter the campground until it has been declared safe by authorities.
